

# Park 'n Ride with IndyGo's Race Day Shuttle

U.S. Grand Prix      Sunday, July 2  
Brickyard 400      Sunday, August 6

## Race Day Hints

- Try to purchase your race day shuttle tickets in advance
- Be sure you know the official start of the race
- Estimated travel from boarding area to the IMS is 15-20 minutes
- Keep your ticket for return service
- The last bus departs for the track 15 minutes prior to the official race start
- Take your time returning to the boarding location after the race as service is continuous for 3 hours following the official end of the race
- Listen to local radio for traffic and race shuttle reports

## Parking

- Parking fees **are not included** in the cost of your IndyGo Race Day Shuttle ticket. For more information about downtown parking locations, log on to [www.indydt.com](http://www.indydt.com). For airport shuttle service, parking at the International Arrivals parking lot is recommended. - \$15.00 (round trip or one way; race days only)
- Tickets may be purchased in advance by calling (317) 635-3344/TDD 317.637.0759 or online at [www.indygo.net](http://www.indygo.net). Tickets are also available in advance at the IndyGo Customer Service Center located in the Indianapolis City Market (222 E. Market Street). *Deadline for phone and Internet sales is 10 days before each race day. No will call, refunds or rain checks.*

***Tickets will be available at all boarding locations the day of the race.***

# Race Day Shuttle

## Going to the Indianapolis Motor Speedway

- Shuttle service starts **4 hours** before the official start of each race

## Boarding Locations to the IMS Downtown

- RCA Dome (200 S. Capitol by the Box Office)
- IUPUI lot 73 (off Michigan and Blackford Streets) **New Location**
- Illinois and Market (near the Monument Circle)

## Indianapolis International Airport

- Main Terminal – Lower Level (Lower Terminal Drive)
- International Arrival Parking (Banner Avenue and Pierson Drive)

## Leaving the Indianapolis Motor Speedway

- Shuttle Service is continuous for **3 hours** after the official end of the race.

- 11th and Main Street (Southwest of the IMS)

# IndyGo Fixed Route Service

Before race days, consider using IndyGo's 28 Fixed Routes including the Blue Line Free Downtown Circulator.

## Blue Line Free Downtown Circulator

The Blue Line Free Downtown Circulator is a great way to move around downtown Indianapolis. See the sites from the White River State Park to the Indianapolis City Market. The Blue Line operates from 10 a.m. – 10 p.m., 7-days a week.

## Fixed Route Fare Information:

- \$3 for a Day Pass (unlimited use throughout the day)
- Route information, trip planning assistance and the purchase of Fare Passes are available with exact fare on the bus, by calling 317.635.3344, online at [www.IndyGo.net](http://www.IndyGo.net) or in person at the IndyGo Customer Service Center located in the Indianapolis City Market (222 E. Market St.). No will call.

## Popular Routes:

### Route 25: West 16th Street

From Downtown to the IMS

- Before race days, take IndyGo Bus Route 25 from downtown Indianapolis to the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. No Sunday Service on Route 25.

### Route 8: Washington Street

Service from Downtown to the Airport

- If you are traveling to Indianapolis via the Indianapolis International Airport, you can take the Route 8 to downtown Indianapolis.
