Bush Stadium seats installed at bus stops

IndyGo and the People for Urban Progress are bringing a little **baseball** nostalgia to city bus stops.

Seats from the old Bush Stadium on West 16th Street, where the Indianapolis Indians played for decades until moving Downtown to Victory Field, are being refurbished and used as bus stop seating.

Pilot seating for the PUPstops was installed Monday on Alabama Street south of Vermont Street, along IndyGo routes 2, 5 and 17.

"Not only will these seats provide a comfortable resting place for transit riders, they will also become a form of repurposed public art," Samantha Cross, IndyGo director of business **development**, said in a statement.

Plans call for installing four to five additional PUPstops in the spring. IndyGo and PUP will **accept** sponsorships for the seating.
