Official Rules

Ride & Seek: An IndyGo Foundation Scavenger Hunt Contest

NO PURCHASE OR DONATION NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OR DONATION WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. Sponsor

The Ride & Seek scavenger hunt contest ("Contest") is sponsored by the IndyGo Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, located at 6410 N. College Ave., Indianapolis, IN 46220.

2. Eligibility

This Contest is open to individuals and teams whose members are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry and who reside in the state of Indiana. Employees of the IndyGo Foundation, members of the IndyGo Foundation Board of Directors, and their immediate family members are not eligible to win. Participants must have access to the IndyGo public transportation system and a mobile device compatible with the Eventzee app.

3. Contest Period

The Contest begins at 12:00 AM (ET) on May 1, 2025, and ends at 11:59 PM (ET) on May 11, 2025 ("Contest Period"). All entries and activities must be completed within this timeframe to be eligible.

4. How to Enter

To participate, individuals or teams must:

- Register online at https://iptf.formstack.com/forms/2025 ride and seek registration
- Download the Eventzee app and enter the designated event code provided after registration
- Complete challenges, answer trivia questions, and solve clues using the app and the IndyGo public transportation system

Teams are limited to a maximum of four (4) members.

5. Winner Selection

Winners will be determined based on points earned through the successful completion of tasks, accuracy in trivia responses, and time-based challenges tracked in the Eventzee app. In the event of a tie, a judging panel will evaluate completion times and creativity (if applicable) to determine the final winner(s).

6. Prizes

Individual Participants

- 1st Place: \$250

2nd Place: \$1003rd Place: \$50

Team Participants (shared among team members)

1st Place: \$1,0002nd Place: \$4003rd Place: \$200

All prizes are non-transferable. Winners are responsible for all applicable federal, state, and local taxes.

Donation Option: Winners may choose to donate the value of their prize to the IndyGo Foundation Mobility Access Fund or a local nonprofit organization of their choosing in the form of bus fare. Donation of a prize does not change the tax implications for the winner, and any applicable tax liability remains the responsibility of the winner.

7. Notification of Winners

Winners will be notified by email and/or phone by May 14, 2025. If a winner does not respond within 72 hours, an alternate winner may be selected.

8. Publicity Release

By entering, participants consent to the use of their names, images, and contest participation for promotional purposes without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.

9. Liability and Safety

Participants are responsible for their own safety while navigating public spaces and using public transit. All participants must sign a liability waiver before participating. The IndyGo Foundation is not liable for any injury, loss, or damage that may occur during the Contest. Participants must follow all local laws, IndyGo policies, and Eventzee app terms of service.

10. Tax Reporting

Cash prize winners receiving \$600 or more must complete a W-9 form and will be issued a 1099-MISC for tax reporting purposes.

11. Disqualification

Any attempt to tamper with the Contest process or app functionality, submit false information, or otherwise act in violation of these rules may result in disqualification at the discretion of the IndyGo Foundation.

12. General Conditions

The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws. The IndyGo Foundation reserves the right to cancel or modify the Contest if fraud or technical failure impairs its

integrity.

Participants must comply with all City of Indianapolis ordinances and IndyGo rider policies while participating in Ride & Seek. This includes refraining from disruptive behavior, littering, loitering, or impeding public access to transit spaces and sidewalks. The IndyGo Foundation encourages all participants to act respectfully in public spaces and to prioritize safety, cleanliness, and courtesy throughout the event.
