

# PROPOSED FARE INCREASE

For the first time in 16 years, IndyGo is proposing a fare increase due to rising costs of fuel, labor and maintenance.

## What is Being Proposed?

- › Fare increase: \$1.75 → \$2.75
- › IndyGo Access fare increase:
  - ADA Area: \$3.50 → \$5.50
  - Premium Area: \$7.00 → \$11.00
  - Premium Area Same Day: \$10.00 → \$15.00
- › Retirement of 10-Trip, 31-Day, S-Passes & Summer Youth Passes
- › If approved, fare increases would take effect Jan. 1, 2026.

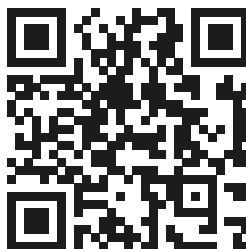
## Why It Matters
