


CONSTRUCTION NOTICE



INDYGO BLUELINE WATER RELOCATIONS - IRVINGTON

In preparation for the upcoming IndyGo Blue Line construction, Citizens Energy Group has been asked to relocate water mains along Washington Street through the Irvington neighborhood. Construction will begin on or after March 16, 2026. Water main relocation is expected to take 3 to 3.5 months.

Here's what you need to know:

- Starting March 16, the first phase involves a three-week closure of the Ritter & Washington Street intersection.
- Crews will then move to the stretch of Washington Street from North Irvington Avenue to Arlington Street.
- On or after April 6, there will be a two-week closure of westbound traffic along Washington Street, between Layman Avenue and Audubon Road.

What should you expect?

- Work will consist primarily of lane restrictions, with some temporary lane closures around the medians.
- Some impact on street parking is expected. Crews will make every effort to maintain local access to nearby businesses and buildings.
- Construction also will require temporary water outages, which will be communicated to those impacted in advance.

Coordinated with this construction to limit its impact, the Citizens Lead Service Line Replacement Program (LSLRP) will also replace any water service lines made of lead owned by the property owners in the construction zone at no additional cost to customers. This work and associated detours are depicted in the attached graphic. Commuters should follow all posted signage to avoid delays.
